





Cultural Program 2025



At the end of April, the city of Logroño fills its streets with artistic interventions through the International Festival of Architecture and Design of Logroño, the aim of which is to invite the spectator to reflect on the urban environment and the city.

The Festival invites you to explore the city through installations, exhibitions, meetings and activities that propose new collective uses, strengthening the idea of community in the public space.

These urban interventions have been created by teams of national and international architects and designers experimenting with new fields of environmental design.



Mayo Jazzea is the jazz festival of the city of Logroño. Since its beginnings, more than twenty years ago, it has consisted of first-class concerts held every Thursday in May. These concerts continue to be the backbone of the festival, to which are added more street concerts, meetings with musicians and a film series, completing a whole month of May in which jazz is the musical protagonist of the city.



Since 2016, at the end of August, MUWI La Rioja Music Fest has been held, a festival with the main objective of turning Logroño into an international benchmark for wine tourism and culture, highlighting some of the city's hallmarks: wine, cuisine and heritage.

To this end, and as a differentiating element, it has structured a first-class musical proposal in unique settings that enhance the city's heritage (the Revellín Wall, the gardens and cellars of the century-old Franco Españolas wineries and the Laurel Zone), as well as its culinary richness and its wine culture.

It is, to date, the most relevant, recognised and multitudinous wine tourism event in Logroño, both in terms of its programme, the number of tourists and locals attending the festival, and the national and international recognition it has received.



Held during the month of November for four consecutive days, the Ancient Music Week fills the city with medieval, renaissance or baroque pieces with instruments typical of each period. On the one hand, the Riojaforum Chamber Hall hosts four major concerts that are the main focus of the festival. In addition, the concerts are preceded by the Aperitivos Musicales; small concerts offered by Rioja Filarmonía on the terrace of Riojaforum, where the spectator can enjoy listening to small musical pieces with the spectacular scenery of the Ribera del Ebro in the background, accompanied by an appetizer.



Faithful to its annual engagement, during the month of November, the CUÉNTALO Festival fills the streets of Logroño with literature, theatre, comics, art, theatre, journalism, illustration and music. During these autumn days, dozens of stories, characters and protagonists come together in the city. Their authors go out to meet readers, generate conversations and nurture concerns and affections.

The activities take place in different places, involving all kinds of cultural spaces: libraries, bookshops, exhibition halls, etc.
